

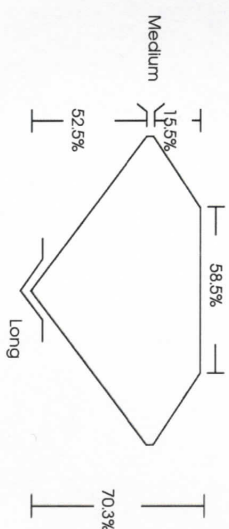

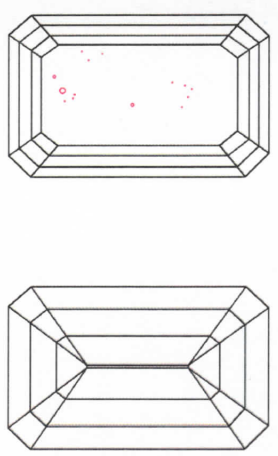

IGI's grading and testing procedures include the use of advanced techniques and equipment currently available to IGI, including, without limitation, 10X magnification, corrected triplet loupe, binocular microscope, master color comparison stones, non-contact optical measuring device, Spectrophotometer and such other instruments and/or processes as deemed appropriate by IGI in the case where diamond inclusions are not visible to the naked eye. IGI's grading and testing procedures include the use of a diamond grading origin will be performed.
