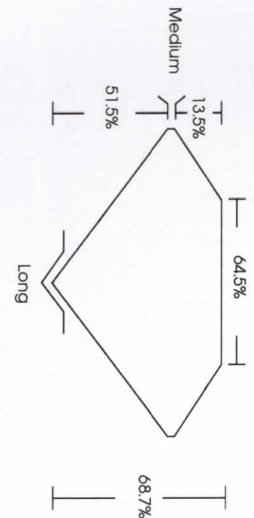

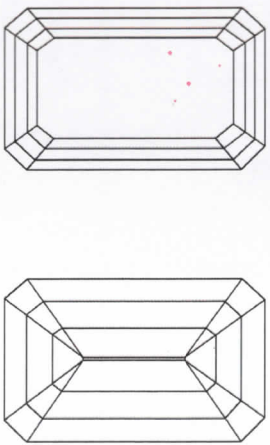

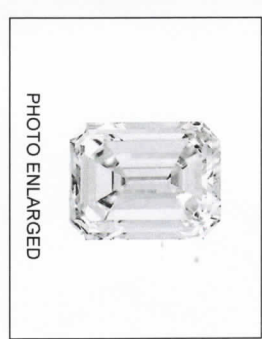

In the case where a diamond is set in a mounting, a random testing procedure, regarding the diamond being of natural or laboratory created origin will be performed.
